## PROGRAMS AT CAANH

**Connecticut Energy Assistance Program** assists eligible households with payment for primary heating bills.

**Eviction & Foreclosure Program (EFPP)** is housing assistance designed to prevent eviction and foreclosures through Mediation and Rent Bank.

**Individual Development Accounts (IDA)** provides financial-literacy training and matched savings to low-income individuals who are looking to buy a home, start a small business or go to college.

**Manage Your Future (MYF)** aids youth ages 14—18 with social-development skills, financial literacy, job readiness and employment by design.

**Mature Adult Activities Program (MAAP)** provides activities and seminars for active adults 55 and older.

The **Security Deposit Program** provides a guarantee to landlords of up to two months of rent for eligible clients.

**S.M.A.R.T. Women (Single Mothers Actively Reaching the Top)** offers single mothers financial education and case management including managing family issues.

**Surfing With Seniors** offers Seniors 55 and older the opportunity to learn basic computer skills.

**Voluntary Income Tax Assistance (VITA)** offers free tax service to eligible clients.

**Weatherization Program** helps eligible customers receive services that reduce energy consumption and optimize energy efficiency.

## SERVICES AT CAANH

- Family Services provides case management for individuals and families.
- Home Visits are available to eligible individuals who have special needs due to their medically disabling condition
- Outreach Services present CAANH programs and services to the community.
- Passport to Prosperity is a referral process among partners to provide services to clients in a more expedited manner.
- Operation Fuel provides one-time emergency energy assistance to some clients in crises who may not be eligible under the Energy Assistance Program.
- The Open Choice Food Pantry provides an emergency food supply to eligible low income households in New Haven once a month. Customers can choose what goes into their bag(s) from different food groups available.
- The Diaper Bank provides diapers to eligible low-income households in New Haven once a month.
